





### Queen Makeda aka the Queen of Sheba (9th Century BC)

(2 Chronicles 9:1-9) She was from Agama, Ethiopia. She ruled Ethiopia and Egypt for a combined 50 years. She took a journey from Ethiopia to Jerusalem with a large caravan of camels bearing spices, in particular frankincense and myrrh, gold, precious stones and other treasures worth about \$4 Million in modern terms to meet King Solomon. She heard about his great wisdom and the happiness of his subjects. King Solomon was delighted with her visit and "gave the

queen of Sheba all she desired and asked for, besides what he had given her out of his royal bounty. Then she left and returned with her retinue to her own country". (1Kings 10:13 NIV) Before returning to her kingdom, she negotiated important trade route treaties and bore King Solomon a son.



#### Queen Nefertiti, Queen of Egypt (Reigned c. 1353-1336 BCE)

Queen Nefertiti's name means "a beautiful woman has come."She was rumored to be Egypt's most beautiful woman. She was a queen, a priestess, a wife, a mother, a political revolutionary, a beauty icon, and a pharaoh all rolled into one. She ruled alongside her husband,

Pharaoh Amenhotep IV, whom she married when he was 15 years old, before he became pharaoh. They ruled as equals, had six daughters, and one son. They were the ultimate power couple.



#### Queen Vashti, Queen of Persia (Esther 1:1-22)

Her name, Vashti, means "the beloved/desired one." She was married to King Ahasuerus of Persia. In the third year of his reign, King Ahasuerus gave a banquet for all the nobles and governors of the providences. The festivities lasted 180 days (6 months). This was followed by a seven-day feast for all the people of the capital, Susa. After these long nights of drinking with his remembered Vashti and the decree he had ordered guests, Ahasuerus sent for Queen Vashti to appear before him and his guests wearing only her crown to

show off her beauty. When the gueen refused, the King's advisors urged him to depose Vashti so their wives wouldn't be influenced to exercise their own independence. The king stripped Vashti of her title and issued a decree that "every man be lord in his own house." Later, when the king's anger cooled, he against her and he regretted his actions.

#### Queen Charlotte of Mecklenburg-Strelitz (Birthday - May 19, 1744 - November 17, 1818)

Wife of King George III whom she married at age 17 having never met him before her wedding (six hours after they first met). She was the longest serving Queen Consort of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, having been married for 57 years. She was also the mother of 15 children. In December 1800 Queen

Charlotte set up the first known English Christmas tree at Queen's Lodge, Windsor. The practice of decorating a tree became popular among the British nobility and later spread to the colonies. Many places around the world are named after Queen Charlotte including Charlotte, NC.



### Queen Dihya Al-Kahina (Early 7th Century - 703 AD)

This warrior queen was fearless. She led the resistance against Arab invasion of North Africa. The queen ruled over a Judaized Berber tribe in modern-day Algeria's Aures Mountains. She is described as being a "tall very dark-skinned woman with great (dreadlocks) of hair with huge eyes" who adorned herself with jewelry. She was

believed to be a prophetess, a spiritual gift that allowed her to see and prepare for upcoming battles. She is the most legendary figure in all ancient North African history, a symbol of strength and female empowerment today.



### Empress Taytu Betul (1851 – February 11, 1918)

Taytu Betul was a formidable Ethiopian Empress who fought colonization. The extraordinary queen reigned for 14 years, during which time she led her troops in a memorable battle and negotiated peace treaties. She founded and established Ethiopia's modern capital city, Addis Ababa, during the country's territorial expansion. She contributed significantly to Ethiopia's reputation as the only African nation that has never been colonized.
